SAFETY MEASURES

Our team is grateful that we can stay connected with you through virtual services in this time. As the province plans to reopen services, we want to ensure that we continue to follow the recommendations of our professional organizations. As of May 5, the Alberta College of Speech-Language Pathologists (ACSLPA) and other professional colleges recommend that we prioritize virtual service delivery whenever possible. In the event of face-to-face home visitation, we are committed to assess the risk together with you and to follow the recommended safety measures:



We will maintain a 6 feet (or 2 metres) physical distance whenever possible.



We will attend your home wearing personal protective equipment (PPE) in case we cannot ensure physical distancing.



If anyone in your household is feeling sick, please let us know and the visit will be rescheduled.



We ask that families commit to cleaning and disinfecting any areas we need to be in before and after the visit.



To reduce risk and spread from common surfaces, we will no longer bring company toys to your home.

In addition, we are advised to follow strict procedures that include but are not limited to:

- Pre-screening and onsite questionnaires
- Pre-visit planning conversations
